Adams County Ranks Third Nationally in Job Growth

Adams County employers are adding jobs at one of the fastest rates in the nation. In a report published Thursday by the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment in Adams County increased by 6.4 percent between December 2013 and December 2014. The national average for job growth during that time was 2.2 percent. The county's growth rate in 2013 was 4.7 percent.

According to the federal report, Adams County has enjoyed steady growth over the past 12 months. "We were thrilled with the results we saw in 2013 and this year's result is further proof that the business climate in the county is attractive," said Board of County Commissioners Chair Charles "Chaz" Tedesco. "We look forward to helping our existing and prospective businesses so we can sustain this growth in employment."

Adams County is proud to join our neighbors to the north in Weld County on the list. With 8.0 percent growth over the same period, Weld County ranked first among the largest counties in the country.
