Cardboard Balls

You will need:

- Toilet paper roll
- Scissors

To assemble a cardboard ball:

- 1. Cut a toilet paper roll into five slices
- 2. Stick slices together by weaving them in and out of each other
- 3. Try different weaving patterns until the slices no longer move. Once the pieces are tight, you're all done!



Pipe Cleaner Spirals

You will need:

- Pipe cleaners
- Pencil
- Scissors

To assemble a pipe cleaner spiral:

- 1. Cut a pipe cleaner in half
- 2. Wrap the pipe cleaner tightly around a pencil
- 3. Remove the pipe cleaner and lightly pull apart at either end. Now you're all done!



Pipe Cleaner Spiders

You will need:

- Pipe cleaners
- Scissors

To assemble a pipe cleaner spider:

- 1. Cut a pipe cleaner into four equal segments
- 2. Separate the segments into groups of two
- 3. Fold each group of two over each other in the middle, twisting them tightly
- 4. Once the segments are secure, bend the legs to resemble a spider ☺



Catnip Boxes

You will need:

- Toilet paper roll
- Catnip
- Scissors

To assemble a catnip box:

- 1. Cut toilet paper roll in half
- 2. Fold the bottom of the roll inside of itself to create a sealed bottom
- 3. Fill the roll with catnip and fold the top to seal it ☺




Paper Fans

You will need:

- A standard piece of paper
- Pipe cleaner
- Scissors

To assemble a paper fan:

- 1. Hold your paper horizontally. Cut it into three equal pieces
- 2. Fold one strip of paper several times to make an accordion
- 3. Cut a small slit in the middle of your accordion, on each side
- 4. Fold the end of a pipe cleaner around the accordion, inside the slits
- 5. Fan out your accordion and you're ready to go!



Sock Mice

You will need:

- Baby socks
- Stuffing
- Catnip
- Yarn

To assemble a sock mouse:

- 1. Fill a sock with stuffing and a sprinkle of catnip
- 2. Pinch the top of the sock and tie it off with a piece of yarn ©
