



RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS REQUIRING AND NOT REQUIRING BUILDING PERMITS

Building Permits are required for the following projects:

- Fences over 42 inches tall.
- Retaining walls over 24 inches from bottom of the footing (engineering req'd)
- Lawn sprinklers
- Pools, hot tubs, and spas
- Roofing\Reroofing
- Siding and stucco
- Room additions
- Attached and detached garages
- Accessory buildings larger than 200 square feet
- Evaporative coolers (swamp coolers)
- Air conditioning units
- Patio enclosures
- Gas lines
- Furnace installation or replacement
- Water heater installation or replacement
- Boiler installation or replacement
- Gas logs and gas lines
- Fireplaces (wood, pellet or gas)
- Basement finishes
- Remodeling
- Plumbing modifications
- Structural modifications
- Mechanical modifications
- Electrical modifications
- Electric to gas conversions
- Installation of additional windows or doors
- An increase or decrease of window or door size
- Decks over 30 inches above ground level
- Any deck with attached roofs.
- Patio covers' awnings and carports
- Storage sheds larger than 200 sq. ft.
- Electrical circuit wiring
- Electrical Service Change

Building Permits not required for the following projects:

- Replacing plumbing fixtures
- Replacing cabinets and counter tops
- Replacing windows and doors (same size)

- Decks not more than 30 inches above ground level, less than 200 SF and not attached
- Flooring
- Wallpaper
- Painting
- Storage sheds 200 square feet or less
- Gazebos 200 square feet or less
- General landscaping
- Concrete flatwork
- Painting
- Fences less than 42 inches tall
- Minor roofing repair (1 square or less)
- Minor fence picket repair
- Retaining walls 24 inches or less from bottom of footing
